2021 KAWASAKI MOTORCYCLE LINEUP

KAWASAKI RETURNS IN 2021 WITH A MOTORCYCLE FOR EVERY RIDER

The Kawasaki 2021 line of motorcycles has a motorcycle for various types of riders with a wide range of options covering hypersport, supersport, sport, naked, adventure, touring, dual-purpose and cruiser models.

HYPERSPORT

Ninja H2™R

The development of the Ninja H2™R goes beyond the boundaries of any other Kawasaki motorcycle. 'Built Beyond Belief' and crafted by Kawasaki Heavy Industries, Ltd. (KHI) Aerospace Company, the world's only limited production supercharged hypersport model represents the unbridled pinnacle of Kawasaki engineering, with astonishing acceleration and mind-bending top speed suitable only for the track. Featuring a 998cc inline four-cylinder engine, proprietary supercharger, lightweight trellis frame, compact superbike dimensions, carbon fiber aerodynamic devices, fully adjustable high-performance racing suspension and a rigid single-sided swingarm. This track-only motorcycle also features Kawasaki Launch Control Mode (KLCM), Brembo Stylema® monobloc calipers, Öhlins rear shock, highly durable self-healing paint and sits at the head of the class in advanced electronics and technological development. The 2021 Ninja H2R is available in Mirror Coated Matte Spark Black with an MSRP of \$55,500.

Ninja H2™ and H2™ Carbon

The Ninja H2™ and Ninja H2™ Carbon motorcycles amount to pure street legal hypersport performance. Featuring a 998cc inline four-cylinder engine, proprietary supercharger, lightweight trellis frame, compact superbike dimensions, aerodynamic bodywork, and a rigid single-sided swingarm. Both models feature high-spec Brembo Stylema® brake calipers, Kawasaki Quick Shifter (KQS), Kawasaki Traction Control (KTRC-9 modes) and Kawasaki's highly durable self-healing paint. In the cockpit, a TFT (thin-film transistor) color instrumentation display with four selectable display modes, as well as Bluetooth Smartphone Connectivity (using RIDEOLGY THE APP*). Bringing all this power and technology to the pavement are Bridgestone RS11 tires. The Ninja H2 Carbon was developed as a special, limited edition model that features beautiful, strong and lightweight carbon fiber front bodywork and special insignia. The 2021 Ninja H2 is available in Mirror Coated Spark Black with an MSRP of \$29,500, while the 2021 Ninja H2 Carbon is offered in Mirror Coated Matte Spark Black / Candy Flat Blazed Green with its clear coated raw carbon fiber fairing on display and an MSRP of \$33,000.

Ninja H2™ SX SE+

Kawasaki's Ninja H2™ SX SE+ is where luxury and performance reach stunning new heights. The balanced supercharged engine was developed for everyday street-riding situations for relaxed long-distance riding, thrilling acceleration and superb fuel efficiency. Enjoy your exhilarating ride with premium features that make the supercharged bike stand apart as an icon of sport performance, luxury, and style. Supercharge your journey. The 2021 Ninja H2™ SX SE+ features a 998cc liquid-cooled four-cylinder balanced supercharged engine, and advanced electronics and features such as: Electronic Cruise Control, Kawasaki Corner Management Function (KCMF), High-tech instrumentation, Kawasaki Quick Shifter (KQS), full color LCD display, Kawasaki Launch Control Mode (KLCM), Kawasaki

The 2021 Ninja ZX-6R features a 636cc in-line four-cylinder DOHC engine, Kawasaki Quick Shifter, high-grade instrumentation, styling with twin LED headlights and taillight, Kawasaki Intelligent anti-lock Brake System (KIBS), Selectable power modes combined with Kawasaki Traction Control (KTRC), Class-leading SHOWA suspension, SHOWA SFF-BP fork, Assist & Slipper Clutch, updated ergonomics with adjustable clutch lever, Multi-function LCD screen, and a pressed-aluminum perimeter frame. Non-ABS models are available in Pearl Nightshade Teal / Metallic Spark Black and Pearl Crystal White / Pearl Storm Gray / Ebony and have an MSRP of \$10,199. The Ninja ZX-6R ABS KRT Edition is available in a Lime Green / Ebony / Pearl Blizzard White color scheme with an MSRP of 11,499.

Ninja® ZX™-14R

For 2021, the Ninja 400 and the Ninja 400 ABS are available in Passion Red and Pearl Nightshade Teal / Metallic Spark Black. A third option for the Ninja 400 ABS is available in Metallic Graphite Gray / Metallic Magnetic Dark Gray. MSRP for the non-ABS models starts at \$4,999. MSRP for the ABS models starts at \$5,399.
